Board of Directors

The Board of Directors met on December 19, 2022 at The Centre. Past President Jim Brady attended the meeting and presented a history of the "Adult Lifestyle Community" signage in Canterbury Common. The original sign appeared 30 years ago and was replaced with larger sign on Waterbury at Coulter. The second sign was removed during construction and replaced with the stone monument on the traffic island. Jim reviewed the governing documents for CCRA and the OMB Minutes of Settlement. The Board confirmed its decision to proceed with a replacement sign. The matter has been referred back to House and Property for completion when feasible.

The Office Services report was presented with the survey responses from the seven standing committees and the Secretary and Treasurer. With two exceptions all of the responses indicated that the committees and the officers are able to manage their responsibilities without assistance from office personnel. The two exceptions were the bookkeeper and the records manager. The bookkeeper supports the Treasurer in the processing of income and expense transactions. The records manager is a temporary position to help with the registration of resale purchasers and Geranium buyers for the next six months. The Board discussed future needs due to the growth of the community. Everyone felt that volunteers could manage any additional work but the Board is also committed to hiring personnel for work that cannot be done by volunteers.

The Board passed a motion to amend article 9 in By-Law 1 regarding Election and Term of Office. The motion included two amendements. The first change is retain the two-year term but to remove the rotation of four and five directors that has not been possible for the last seven years due to illnesses and resignations. The second change is to remove the requirement that Members in the same home must have a one-year lapse after serving a total of two consecutive two-year terms. The amendments have been sent to the ONCA committee for review. There will be a Town Hall meeting in the spring to present all the amendments to By-Law 1.

The Administration commttee has approved new procedures for private rental of The Centre by residents which the Board has supported. The committee is discussing improvements for office security and the storage project is making progress. The Pool sub-committee will present some new guidelines to the Board in January.

The Communications committee completed the Winter Chronicle that was delivered this week. The committee has consolidated the process for distributing information via the website, email, bulletin board and electronic message display. On the website there is a new format for membership records for each home and the calendar has been improved to allow access to future events.

The Governance committee submitted the monthly update on site visits. There was a special meeting with area realtors to discuss information about Canterbury Common. The committee is engaged in the Meet and Greet meetings to welcome new residents and has completed a Resident Satisfaction Survey.

Malcolm Ward will be assuming the chair of House and Property in January 2023. A decision was made to maintain Barry's Path this winter and the proposal for solar lighting on the path will be considered in the budget request for next year. The committee is awaiting a quote for a standalone sign that may be placed at The Centre. The topsoil for the bunkers on the Lakeside Meadows can be delivered when the ground has frozen. The extension from Barry's Path to the Lakeside Meadows will be completed when the contractor is available.

The Social committee convened the drive for Operation Scugog Food Bank on December 16th. See the article below. Plans were announced for Christmas Carolling on December 22nd. Tree decorations will be removed on January 1st and storage reorganization will take place on January 5th. The committee is eager to restart social events in the new year.

The Canterbury Transition Committee held its monthly meeting with Geranium. A number of tasks are ongoing from last month. The CTC is working with Geranium, the Township of Scugog and Greenwood Retirement Communities to remove the construction fences at Country Estates and Simcoe. Hydroseeding has been scheduled for next spring on the site for the seniors residence.

We received 28 written surveys at The Centre and the Township noted that several other surveys were submitted online based on our postal codes.

Over 20 residents attended our focus group meeting on October 31, 2022 and provided feedback provided which was genuinely appreciated by the Township representatives.

HOUSE AND PROPERTY COMMITTEE

Centre North Hall - Light Switch Relocation:

The on/off switch controlling the first bank of lights (library area) in the north hall has been relocated. A new switch has been located on the hallway side of the doorway (left hand side) as you enter the area. It too is an on/off switch and should be very user friendly once it's new location becomes common knowledge. As with its predecessor, it does not have an automatic shut off feature. The "old" switch has been removed. Our apologies for any inconvenience the above change may cause. There was a safety concern associated with the way things were. Hopefully that concern has now been addressed.

Snow/Ice Clearing

Home owners are responsible for clearing any build up of ice or snow in front of their properties that can occur due to wind and or freezing and thawing in between contracted clearings. This will allow sidewalks to be safe to walk on at all times. De-icing bins have been located around the Centre, Mail Kiosk and Barry's Pathway, for residents use in between contracted salting for spreading as needed.

New Path

The new path extension to Barry's pathway south of the Centre will commence during early winter, as soon as the vendor is able to proceed.

Not much activity for the Municipal Affairs officer again this month. Some dead trees were pointed out to the Township and they promised to remove then after nesting season. I'm afraid I failed to take note if all of this was accomplished. I'll check in the spring and depend on other residents to let me know if they see any omissions.
