REVISED CCRA Outdoor Activity Guidelines – August 28, 2022

Welcome to the CCRA Outdoor Games area. This area was designed for you and we hope you enjoy the activities.

Daily Activity hours: No set hours

<u>Access:</u> The storage shed has been moved inside the Lower Level of the Centre to the left of the door. It will no longer be locked. You will need your fob to access the Centre.

Due to the grass cutting in the area, equipment not secured cannot be left out. Therefore we ask that you follow the guidelines outlined below.

- 1. All equipment will be stored in the storage shed located on the deck outside the lower level except for the pop up badminton net (rackets & birdies will be in the storage shed). The pop up badminton will be stored inside the lower level of the Centre.
- 2. Equipment details:
 - a. Horseshoes these have been built using regulation specs. If one finds it too far to pitch from the pitching location (48'), then people can choose their own distance.
 - b. Corn Hole inside the boards are the corn bags, a bag containing a 27' string (the distance between the 2 boards) and a cloth to wipe down the boards before putting them back in the black covers. Corn Hole can be set up anywhere but the scoreboard is on the west side of the pathway, parallel to the Horseshoe Pits (see map).
 - c. Croquet In the equipment bag, there is a smaller bag with the wickets and 3 6' strings to measure distance between wickets.
 - d. Badminton the rackets and a white bag containing the birdies & stakes will be in the shed.
 - e. Table Tennis/ping pong the table will remain on the deck please cover the table once you have finished playing. The cover is all-weather and will protect the table.
- 3. A sign out/in sheet will be posted. Please note the date, out/in and indicate the activity.
- 4. Rules for each game will be in a plastic folder on the shelf in the storage shed.
