The Board of Directors met on April 17, 2023 at the Centre. The directors shared the annual reports from their respective committees. The Board received a comprehensive report on the solar bollards to light Barry's Path this summer. Section 1 of the Policies and Guidelines was revised in preparation for a meeting of all committees on May 1. The Board will meet again on April 26 to review the agenda and documents for the Annual Meeting.

The amendments were sent by email to all residents on April 4 and one reply was received. The amendments were discussed at four committee meetings last week. The first of two Town Hall meetings took place on April 17. Five residents attended the presentation. The second Town Hall will be held on May 23. A copy of the amendments will be provided to all residents who register for the Annual Meeting.

Greenwood Retirement Communities

The company has changed its name to LEV Senior Living. LEV has scheduled removal of the construction fences and hydro seeding of the property at Block 100 to begin shortly. As previously reported, LEV will make a decision by the end of this year on proceeding with the project.

HOUSE AND PROPERTY COMMITTEE

- Work will commence this spring on the pathway extension from the north end of Barry's path around the north end of the Settlement Pond and completion is targeted to be in time for the pool opening in May.
- Concrete pads for the eight benches will be poured in the next several weeks, weather permitting. The benches will be installed after the requisite two-week curing period.
- The Centre Lift License Reactivation process with TSSA (The Technical Standards & Safety Authority) has been progressing in recent weeks. TSSA has been onsite and has reactivated our license. The lift is back in operation!
- Centre Hall Acoustic improvements: Sound baffles for the Centre's north and south halls, to improve the acoustics, are being researched. These baffles would reduce the sound reverberations due to the hard surfaces on the floor, walls and ceiling.
- The Gardening Sub Committee is still looking for a Coordinator role and the volunteer job posting has been submitted onto the CCRA website job opening page.
- In addition to a coordinator, the Garden Committee is looking for residents interested in helping to develop/maintain the various gardens located throughout Canterbury.
